Equine Vaccination Certificates:

All horses/ponies should have received a vaccination within 12 months of the date of the competition having already received their initial course of injections. There must be six clear days between the last vaccination and the date of the competition. Random checks will be taking place.

Personal Protection Equipment:

Hats meeting the current standards must always be worn and securely fastened when mounted. Body Protectors are mandatory for the Cross-country phase and must be up to the current standard.

Prize Givings:

There will be a mounted prizegiving for the top 6 in the Three-Day Events. There will be a podium prize giving for all Two-Day and One-Day Event classes.

Number Bibs:

Numbers will be provided and available for collection on site at the riders briefing or the show office.

Dressage Sheets & Prizes:

Will be available for collection at the event only.

Catering

Hot and cold refreshments available throughout the event.

Entertainment

There will be a rider briefing and welcome drink on Thursday night at 6pm.

There will be a party with music at the onsite marquee on Saturday night. All welcome.

Course Walking

Rules of the Competition.

All aspects of the competition will be scored in accordance with internationally accepted scoring for the sport of eventing.

Horse Inspections (Trot ups)

For the 3 Day Event competitors, there will be 2 formal Horse Inspections. The formal horse inspections will take place on a firm road. The Vet will ensure that the horses are fit to compete and the vet's decision is final and there can be no appeal against their decision.

For the two formal Horse Inspections, riders will be given times at which they should be available to present their horses to the panel.

Terms and Conditions

1. The horse trials will be run mainly in conjunction with internationally recognised rules for the sport of eventing
2. Hard hats to BE/PC/RC specifications must be worn at all times when mounted.
3. Body protectors to current BE/PC/RC standards are recommended in all phases but are compulsory for the cross-country phase. Air Jackets may be worn but must be worn over a body protector.
4. It is compulsory that every person entering Cirencester Park who is under the age of 18 years of age is accompanied by a responsible adult.
5. Event stopwatches are allowed.
6. It is compulsory that all dogs must be kept on leads at all times.
7. Horseboxes are not to be mucked out on site.
8. The Management of Cirencester Park & Musketeer Event Management reserves the right to remove anyone from the event at any time without giving a reason.
9. A paramedic team will be in attendance at the event.
10. A vet and a farrier will either be present or on call.
11. The event may be cancelled without notice due to adverse weather. In the event of adverse weather, it is recommended that you check social media @musketeerevents and the website www.musketeer.co.uk before you depart.
12. All horses/ponies must be 4 years and over.
13. No horse/pony may compete in more than one class.
14. Any queries or complaints must be in writing and handed to the Organiser within 30 minutes of the incident
15. *Withdrawals must be made in writing to entries@musketeer.co.uk. After the entries have closed (17/09/24), entries will only receive a refund if their entry is replaced. All refunds will be less a £15 admin fee per entry.*
16. In the event of any rider travelling to a show on their own, details of a contact should be left with the secretary in case of an accident.
17. Any person who fails to comply with these terms & conditions will be liable to forfeit their fees & expulsion from the showground.
18. Booking fee will be payable on entry, this is non-refundable.
19. Start fees will be refunded if an entry does not start.

Cancellation policy

The cancellation of any event run by Musketeer Event Management will follow this policy unless the event is cancelled due to adverse weather conditions and is covered by our wet weather insurance policy.

Unaffiliated Event:

Prior to closing entries (CoE) or 21 days prior to event, whichever occurs first – 100%

Post CoE:

Stage 1 - Before Close of Entry Date - Full refund

Stage 2 - Between Close of Entry Date to 14 days prior to the start date of the competition – 50% refund

Stage 3 - Between 6 to 13 days prior to the event start date – 30% refund

Stage 4 - Between 5 days of the event starting and 17:00 before - 15% refund

Stage 5 - From 17:00 the day before the event day in question - no refund

Refund of start fees will be provided except where competitors have started the dressage phase of their competition.

Onsite Stabling:

Stage 1 - From confirmed of booking and payment of stables by MEM to the supplier (10- 12 days) prior to when stables open, until 5 days prior to Stables open - 40% of stabling fee refunded.

Stage 2 - 5 days prior to Stables open to the start of competition - 20% of stabling fee refunded

Hookup:

From confirmed booking and payment of generator/cabling etc. MEM will deduct all associated cost at the point of cancellation and then refund the balance between each booked hookup equally.

Other Terms

- All refunds for stabling and hook up will remain at the discretion of the Organisers and a refund level for one event may not be the same as for another.
- All entry refunds will be entry fee + VAT as paid at the time of entry but will not include any transaction fees imposed by the e-commerce or entry portal facilitator.
- All refunds will be made within 21 days of the intended date of the event. Only the minimum refund will be set out in the event's schedule. - As soon as possible after the event has been abandoned (and no later than 6 weeks) Events are requested to make additional refunds if event costs allow, based on the principle that events should not profit from an abandonment. Details of this are to be agreed.
- Consideration into creating this refund policy are almost entirely financial both those supplier whom will have committed in good faith to supplying the event and therefore the sport as well as for MEM as a business. These considerations are based on costs incurred rather than revenue/profit lost. We recognise there will be not winners in any of these circumstances.

We sincerely acknowledge and appreciate the patronage of all Owners, Riders, Volunteers and Sponsors and we will do all we can to be balanced and fair in what are challenging times for all concerned.

Health and Safety

The organisers have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone attending this event. For these measures to be effective everyone present must themselves take reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents. Instructions given by any Official must be obeyed. Any animal not under control or in any way constituting a danger may be asked to leave the showground. Owners enter their horses/ponies at their own risk, and it is a condition of entry that no liability of any kind attaches itself to Musketeer Event Management.

Personal Injury and Equipment Insurance Notice

Musketeer Event Management does not insure the rider, your horse or your tack and equipment. You are strongly advised to have in place your own adequate personal accident insurance at all times. The Venue, Musketeer Event Management or anyone involved in the organisation of the event will not be held responsible for any accident, injury or loss to any person or their property however this may be caused.
