You will need your own number bibs – these will not be provided on the day, nor will any numbers. Please print your own numbers.

Any rider competing without support please inform the secretary on the day.

RULES

GENERAL RULES ALL CLASSES

HAT STANDARDS: All hats must have a visible Pink BRC/Pony Club/BE hat tag in place before they are used for warming up and competing. There will be a trained steward available on the day that will be carrying out hat tagging if your hat does not already have a tag.

HATS must be worn whenever mounted and conform to; British Standard Riding Hats as set out by British Eventing, British Riding Clubs and Pony Clubs.

All hats must carry a Cotswold Cup Tag or 2023 PC or RC tag.

ONLY Jockey skull hats without a peak may be worn for cross country. Hat silks may be worn with flexible peak. It must also comply with the above safety standards for hats.

BODY PROTECTORS: A body protector is obligatory for all arena eventing and cross-country events and are also strongly recommended for all show jumping events. A BETA Body protectors should be fitted and worn as per the manufacturer's instructions. You are NOT ALLOWED to wear a BETA Level 3 body protector with a 2000 label. New label must show 2018.

If a rider chooses to wear an airbag style body protector it must be worn over a permitted body protector and if activated, must be deflated or removed before continuing. Hybrid Air jackets and Helite Air Jackets are permitted. It is recommended that body protectors are replaced once they are more than 5 years old. Riders wearing Exo Body Cage protectors must inform the secretary at all events.

Back protectors must be presented to the official steward for checking when declaring.

The use of HEAD CAMS are strictly prohibited. This includes use on the head, chest, bridle or any other part of the horse or rider.

Medical armbands are advised but not compulsory and must be worn on the arm & filled out with up-to-date information.

Stop watches are permitted

CORRECT dress & footwear with defined heels must be worn. Long hair is to be suitably tied up.

HORSES:

Horses must be at least 5 years of age. The age will be calculated from the 1st January in the year in which it was foaled.

Horses must be entered in their full passport name

Horses can have unlimited British Eventing Foundation points. Horses with novice or above BE points cannot qualify for Cotswold Cup Championships as per published rules on website. If they have acquired points in the preceding two seasons they can compete at the qualifiers but will not gain points towards Championships qualification.

<u>COMPETITORS</u>: Competitors must be at least 10 years old for 70cm, 80cm and 90 cm classes and at least 12 years old for the 100cm classes, **It is compulsory that every person entering the one-day event under 18 years of age is accompanied by a responsible adult.**

The fall of a competitor in any phase of the event results in elimination. Any rider who falls must be checked by the Doctor prior to leaving the site.

Outside assistance is forbidden and will result in elimination.

Anyone on the event site must expect to have their photograph taken and we reserve the right to publish suitable photographs along with names if relevant. If you do not wish for your photograph to be taken, please inform the secretary.
